Daily - Ballet Barre (45 mins)

2xWeek - Tap Center (30 mins)

2xWeek - Tahitian/Hula (1 hr)

2xWeek - Jazz Center (30)

2xWeek - Tumbling (1hr)

4xWeek - Improvisation/Free style (15 mins)

1xWeek - Review of dances and songs learned (1.25 hr)

Morning Dance Camp Dress Code

Girls - Pink convertible tights for use in tumbling, Pink leotard and Pink skirt, pink ballet shoes, and white tap shoes. Items can all be purchased from the office

Boys - White top, black tights, white socks, white ballet shoes, dance belt

Hair: Hair should be pulled away from the face and worn in a bun if long enough. Leg warmers and t-shirts are not permitted during technique classes but may be worn during rehearsals and in between classes.

Students are not allowed to wear jewelry in class.

What to bring: water bottle, yoga mat, snacks and lunch
