DANCE DRESS CODE



Girls: Pink convertible tights for use in tumbling, Pink leotard and Pink skirt, pink ballet shoes, and white tap shoes. Items can all be purchased from the office;

Boys: White top, black tights, white socks, white ballet shoes, dance belt.

Musical Theater Dress Code: Shorts, sweats, and t-shirts.

Hair: Hair should be pulled away from the face and worn in a bun if long enough. Leg warmers and t-shirts are not permitted during technique classes but may be worn during rehearsals and in between classes. Students are not allowed to wear jewelry in class.

What to bring: water bottle, yoga mat, snacks and lunch.
